

Notes for all walkers

- Walks start promptly at the published start time.
- Please arrive 10 minutes before the start time for registration.

- Suitable footwear should be worn for off-road walking.
- Dogs (except guide or assistance dogs) are not allowed.
- Walkers under the age of 16 must be accompanied by a responsible adult.

Grades

Grade 1: Gentle walk on flat surfaces for people returning or new to exercise

Grade 2: Slow to medium paced walk that may include moderate slopes, steps and uneven surfaces.

Grade 3: Medium paced walk that may include moderate slopes, steps and uneven surfaces

Grade 4: Medium to fast paced walk that include slopes, uneven paths and steps.

Grade 5: Fast paced walks that include slopes, uneven paths and steps. These are our most challenging and suitable for people with a good level of fitness
